NB: The applicable KCSE aggregate is mandatory for all courses. Applicants with either the 1 ½, 2 years or short-course qualification are therefore required to have met the aggregate before applying for Diploma or any other full-time course.

The fee covers tuition, meals, accommodation at the College, limited medical care (at the College’s clinic), textbooks and uniforms. The fee is subject to change from time to time. Candidates wishing to sponsor themselves are required to submit an irrevocable letter of financial guarantee for the full payment of fees. We wish to emphasize that admission is subject to meeting the academic qualifications and availability of places in the course applied for. **International applicants** are requested to submit their applications not later than the end of February of the intended year of study.

We should take this opportunity to inform all applicants that tuition is in English Language. Accordingly, all applicants are expected to be fluent in both **written** and **spoken English**.

Submit a completed application form, indicating your county/country of birth and ensure that you attach copies of your **KCSE /O level certificate, school leaving certificate and National Identity Card (or Birth Certificate). You should also provide a reliable postal address, email and telephone contact.**
2. The **forms** may be downloaded from Kenya Utalii College Website: www.utalii.ac.ke or collected from Admissions Office-Kenya Utalii College Nairobi or from our Satellite Campuses in Mombasa (Mombasa Trade Centre) and Kisumu (Megacity Plaza).
